Agency History / Creator Sketch:

Otto Lang in partnership with Frank Witchell created what would become the most well respected architectural firm in Dallas, Texas, in 1905. In November 1907 Lang and Witchell joined with 13 other national architectural firms in a competition to design a new court house for Harris County. After over a month of deliberation, the Citizens Committee and the Commissioners Court voted to award the contract to Lang and Witchell. C. E. Barglebaugh, an architect reported but not verified to have trained with Frank Lloyd Wright, actually drew up plans for the courthouse and was Lang and Witchell's representative in Houston during the construction of the building.

Scope and Contents:

Forty architectural drawings on linen record the competition winning designs of Lang and Witchell Architects of Dallas, Texas, for the Harris County Court House. Originally comprised of 43 sheets of drawings (3 are missing), the drawings include floor plans, exterior elevations, plumbing and heating plans, and architectural details. The existent drawings were copied by D. B. McElroy and R. A. Kinnear of Rice University on waxed linen in 1922 from the original plans that had been severely damaged by mold and insects.
